REMINDER

PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE NEW N R W BYE LAWS WHICH CAME INTO OPERATION ON THE 1st JANUARY 2020.

EVERY SALMON THAT YOU CATCH MUST BE RETURNED AS WELL AS EVERY SEA TROUT OVER 600MM IN LENGTH. THERE ARE RESTICTIONS ON HOOK SIZES AND TREBLE HOOKS MAKE YOURSELF FAMILIAR WITH THE NEW BYE LAWS.

THESE BYE LAWS OVER RULE OUR ASSOCIATION RULES.

- Please ensure you are up to date with the Association rules, they are on the associations web
 page if you have lost your association rulebook! : IGNORANCE IS NOT AN ACCEPTABLE
 DEFENCE FOR BREAKING THE RULES. The Association rule on the number of Sea Trout caught
 is still in force.
- 2. Please carry your NRW Licence & Association permit with you whenever you fish our waters. You will be asked to leave the riverbank if you cannot produce them.
- 3. The association can be contacted on Llandeiloangling@gmail.com
- 4. The names and locations of pools on our water can now be seen on the association website.
- 5. Please learn how to identify the difference between a Salmon and a Sea Trout ignorance will not save you from prosecution.
- 6. You can still only keep 2 sea trout every 24 hours.
- 7. Catch and release for sewin on Llandeilo waters is still in place for September.

FARM GATES

Last season once again we had a very irate farmer contacting us, someone had taken a grinder to the latch on the access gate at Llyshendy to make it easier to open, however it became so easy to open that the cattle managed to do it and they all went out onto the road!!!

There is now a style at this location and the gate is not to be used by our permit holders.

Please remember the odds and evens Rule that applies on this pool as per your permit number and the date. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AND THE COMMITTEE WILL BAN ANY PERMIT HOLDER NOT OBEYING.

Fishing Season Dates are:- April 1st to October 17th.

Mandatory Catch & Release Periods

Salmon - 1st April to 17th October

Seatrout - 1st September to 17th October.

Remember the new bye laws relating to the use of certain baits for Sea Trout within certain dates.

Club Rules & the new Byelaws are available to download from the clubs website.

General Note

Remember that the future of our angling is in your hands please handle fish that you are releasing with due care so that they can survive, the future of angling is in our care and we should safeguard it for generations to come .Please do not leave any litter on the riverbank.

GOOSEANDERS AND CORMORANTS
